Ministry of the Month: Facilities/Property Committee

The Property Committee oversees the maintenance and upgrade of Trinity’s buildings and grounds—a major responsibility, especially with most of our facilities now more than 100 years old. A recent assessment identified more than \$2 million in needed repairs and improvements, making a capital campaign essential. The committee, especially Mark Beatty, has responded with energy and dedication. So far, it has overseen 63% of the campus-wide air conditioning replacement, 75% of the Jarrett House renovation, and major cosmetic improvements to Memorial Hall, the Parish House, and the Guild Room. Summer work will include completing the air conditioning project, roofing for the Surprise Shop and Memorial Hall, first-floor flooring in Parish Hall, electrical upgrades in the church, preschool window replacement, and a new columbarium cabinet. This is just half of our list of projects! We hope you are enjoying these improvements and will continue to financially support this important work.
