The Outreach Ministry serves Christ in all people by funding and executing projects that benefit those in need, drawing on Matthew 25:35 to guide its work of responding to hunger, poverty, displacement, and other hardships with love and compassion. Last year's efforts included collecting pet food for homebound individuals, filling backpacks with school supplies, gathering winter clothing for low-income students, donating food to ACTC, and providing sheets and towels for those being released from prison, while also allocating funds to organizations such as Helping Up Mission, Episcopal Relief and Development, ERICA, and Janet's Drawers.
